\*30 studio credits and 18 studies credits from any department within the School of the Arts, Media, Performance & Design (AMPD) are required, with the following specifications:

- A minimum of 18 credits must be from one area (Cinema and Media Arts, Computational Arts, Dance, Music, Theatre, or Visual Art and Art History) – excluding core courses.
- 18 credits must be at the 3000 and/or 4000 level.
- At the 3000/4000 level, at least 6 credits must be from one area (Cinema and Media Arts, Computational Arts, Dance, Music, Theatre, or Visual Art and Art History) – excluding core courses.

## Requirement Checklist and Notes

To ensure graduation, each box must be checked as completed.

- You must fulfill the degree requirements for the year that you entered your current program/stream.** This Advising Worksheet is meant for students who began the Integrative Arts Spec. Hons. BFA in Fall/Winter 2022-2023.
- Overall Grade Point Average** must be at least 5.0 (C+).
- Major Grade Point Average** must be at least 5.0 (C+).
- Upper-level Requirement:** At least 24.0 credits in the major discipline must be at the 3000 or 4000 level.
- Residency Requirement:** A minimum of 30.0 course credits and at least 50% of the course credits required in each undergraduate degree program (major and/or minor) must be taken at York University.

**Note on the General Education Requirement:** Six credits in each of the general areas of the Humanities, the Social Sciences, and the Natural Sciences must be completed within the first 90 credits. Courses must be selected from the following subject areas:
