☐ 6.0 credits from the FA 1900 series of courses outside the major must be completed. (For students admitted to AMPD with 54.0 or more transfer credits this requirement is optional.)
☐ 9.0 Free Elective credits must be outside the major, i.e. may not be FA/VISA or FA/ARTH courses.
Overall Grade Point Average must be at least 4.0 (C).
☐ Major Grade Point Average must be at least 4.0 (C).
☐ Upper-level Requirement: At least 18.0 credits must be at the 3000 level, including at least 12.0 credits in the major. 4000 level credits may not be taken as part of this degree.
☐ Residency Requirement: A minimum of 30.0 course credits and at least 50% of the course credits

Note on the General Education Requirement: Six credits in each of the general areas of the Humanities, the Social Sciences, and the Natural Sciences must be completed within the first 90 credits. Courses must be selected from the following subject areas:
