***REQUIRED:** six credits from the FA 1900 3.00 series of courses, outside the major, are required of all School of the Arts, Media, Performance and Design (AMPD) degrees. These courses may count towards the humanities general education requirement, the In/Out AMPD elective requirement, or the free elective requirement. For students admitted to AMPD with a minimum of 54 transfer credits, the six credits from the FA 1900 3.00 series of courses outside the major are optional. **Selected from FA/ARTH 1900 3.0, FA/CMA 1900 3.0, FA/DATT 1900 3.0, FA/MUSI 1900 3.0, FA/PANF 1900 3.0, and FA/THEA 1900 3.0.**

****IN/OUTS AMPD Electives** may be chosen from the following subject areas: Art History (FA/ARTH), Cinema & Media Arts (FA/CMA), Design (FA/DESN), Digital Media (FA/DATT), Music (FA/MUSI), Interdisciplinary Fine Arts (FA/PANF), Theatre (FA/THEA), Visual Arts (FA/VISA). **Note:** Dance majors must complete at least 3.0 FA/MUSI credits.

Requirement Checklist and Notes

To ensure graduation, each box must be checked as completed.

You must fulfill the degree requirements for the year that you entered your current program/stream.

This Advising Worksheet is meant for students who began the Dance (Choreography & Performance) Spec. Hons. BFA in Fall/Winter 2024-2025.

6.0 credits from the FA 1900 series of courses outside the major must be completed. (For students admitted to AMPD with 54.0 or more transfer credits this requirement is optional.)

3.0 FA/MUSI credits must be completed.

Overall Grade Point Average must be at least 5.0 (C+).

Major Grade Point Average must be at least 5.0 (C+).

Upper-level Requirement: At least 24.0 credits in the major discipline must be at the 3000 or 4000 level.

Residency Requirement: A minimum of 30.0 course credits and at least 50% of the course credits required in each undergraduate degree program (major and/or minor) must be taken at York University.

Note on the General Education Requirement: Six credits in each of the general areas of the Humanities, the Social Sciences, and the Natural Sciences must be completed within the first 90 credits. Courses must be selected from the following subject areas:
